

RESOLUTION #2018 – 60

**RESOLUTION OF THE MANTUA TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL
UTILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE SETTLEMENT
OF THE ONE-CALL VIOLATION OF
180 PHOENIX AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the Mantua Township Municipal Utilities Authority (“MTMUA”), has its principal place of business at 397 Main Street, Mantua, New Jersey 08051; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the MTMUA is the provisioning of water and sewer services to the residents of Mantua Township; and

WHEREAS, in the course of normal operations, the MTMUA was called to do repair work at 180 Phoenix Avenue and in the course of making required repairs, made contact with an improperly installed gas line; and

WHEREAS, as a result of making contact with a gas line the MTMUA was required to call “911” and charges were leveled against the MTMUA by the BPU; and

WHEREAS, it is more cost effective and expedient to settle these charges for a negotiated fine of \$3,000.00 than defend the matter; and

WHEREAS, the Mantua Township Municipal Utilities Authority charged with a violation of one-call of 180 Phoenix Avenue attended a prehearing/mitigation conference on July 19, 2018 with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities and it has been agreed between the parties to resolve this matter with a fine in the amount of \$3,000.00 for failure to call “911” and report making contact with a gas line.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mantua Township Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

1. The Mantua Township Municipal Utilities Authority does hereby authorize the settlement of the one-call violation of not calling "911" as regards 180 Phoenix Avenue and to make a payment of \$3,000.00 as the fine for said violation.
