**RESOLUTION OF THE MANTUA TOWNSHIP  
MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING A  
SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE MANTUA BOARD OF EDUCATION AND  
MANTUA TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY FOR CUSTODIAL  
CLEANING SERVICES**

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**WHEREAS**, the Mantua Township Municipal Utilities Authority (“MTMUA”), has its principal place of business at 397 Main Street, Mantua, New Jersey 08051 and the Mantua Township Board of Education (“Board”) has its principal offices at 684 Main Street, Sewell, New Jersey 08080; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of MTMUA is the provisioning of water and sewer services to the residents of Mantua Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board and MTMUA desire to reduce the costs and improve efficiency for cleaning services and other MTMUA needs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board currently employs a custodian and has committed to dedicating two (2) hours per week from the custodian’s schedule to provide custodial cleaning services to the MTMUA; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Uniformed Shared Services and Consolidation Act. N.J.S.A. 40A:65-J, et seq., municipalities and other local units may enter into Shared Services Agreements with other governmental units by adoption of a Resolution therefore; and

**WHEREAS**, the MTMUA is a local unit as defined by N.J.S.A. 40A:65-3; and

**WHEREAS**, the MTMUA and the Board have concluded that their residents and ratepayers will benefit from the sharing of certain defined services; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties hereto have had a SSA regarding the aforementioned custodial services that has worked beneficially for both parties and now recognize and opportunity to expand the ambit of services that may be

more efficiently provided by one of the parties for their mutual benefit. Accordingly, in recognition of the beneficial and valuable collaborative relationship the MTMUA and the Board have had as regards cleaning services, the parties have agreed to expand the ambit of their agreement to include, for example, as they see fit and if they deem mutually beneficial the following:

- a. HVAC Services
- b. Snow Plowing
- c. Equipment Sharing
- d. Minor electrical and carpentry jobs; and

**WHEREAS**, the proper and respective officials of MTMUA and the Board are authorized to execute the Shared Services Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mantua Township Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

1. The Mantua Township Municipal Utilities Authority does hereby authorize the Director or Chairman to execute the Shared Services Agreement between the MTMUA and the Board, as attached hereto and incorporated herein, from the date of execution through December 31, 2022, unless properly terminated beforehand by the parties.
2. Further, pursuant to said Agreement the MTMUA Director in consultation with the Mantua Board of Education President may develop other areas for shared services as hereinbefore stated in this Resolution and/or state in the referenced Agreement, or newly developed between the parties.
