**RESOLUTION OF THE MANTUA TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL
UTILITIES AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING A CHANGE TO THE PERSONNEL POLICY
FOR THE ADDITION OF A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE REQUIREMENT**

WHEREAS, the Mantua Township Municipal Utilities Authority ("MTMUA"), has its principal place of business at 401 Main Street, Mantua, New Jersey 08051; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the MTMUA is the provisioning of water and sewer services to the residents of Mantua Township; and

WHEREAS, in order to meet the demands of providing quality services to the ratepayers of Mantua Township, the MTMUA must maintain a highly skilled workforce to operate all MTMUA equipment used in the field; and

WHEREAS, the MTMUA has the need for all employees on the MTMUA operations crew to have a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) to ensure that all employees can operate all MTMUA equipment; and

WHEREAS, any current employee who does not have a CDL must acquire one within Six (6) Months of the date of this resolution while every newly hired employee must acquire a CDL within One (1) Year of being hired; and

WHEREAS, the MTMUA will bear the cost for CDL classes and any test fees required for the employee's first attempt to obtain the license; and


WHEREAS, any MTMUA employee who earns a CDL license and leaves the employment of the MTMUA within One (1) Year of obtaining the license will be required to reimburse the MTMUA the cost for the CDL classes, test fees, and other attendant costs while any MTMUA employee who earns a CDL license and leaves the employment of the MTMUA within Two (2) Years of obtaining the license will be required to reimburse the MTMUA One-Half (1/2) of the cost of the CDL classes, test fees, and other attendant costs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mantua Township Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

1. All current employees on the MTMUA operations crew shall have Six (6) Months from June 21, 2022 to obtain a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) as hereinbefore expressed.
2. The Personnel Policy will be updated to reflect the addition of this new Commercial Driver's License (CDL) requirement policy as outlined herein.
