



Construction of upgrades and improvements to **the Mantua Township Municipal Utilities Authority, Construction of Well No. 3A, Contract-A Well Drilling, located in Mantua Township, Gloucester County, New Jersey**, with a capital cost of approximately \$3.5 million, were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project is being undertaken in order to protect and enhance existing water supply infrastructure within the MTMUA service area. Failing to place the well back online, in a timely manner, will only serve to prolong and increase service interruptions. The replacement of the well will serve to protect local water quality and ensure a consistent water supply. Overall, the proposed work will enable MTMUA to keep the municipal infrastructure in good operating condition and to facilitate its continuing efforts to provide effective water supply & fire protection capabilities for its residents, businesses, and industry served by the Mantua Township MUA.
